Project Lifesaver is an innovative and rapidly growing program aiding the victims and families suffering from Alzheimer's Disease and related neurological disorders such as Dementia, Down's Syndrome and Autism. Project Lifesaver uses state-of-the-art technology employing wristband transmitters to locate wandering and lost adults and children. **Recovery times average less than 30 minutes.**

Project Lifesaver, was founded in 1999 in Virginia, and to-date have completed nearly 2000 safe returns without one loss of life. Project Lifesaver is now available to all residents in Onondaga, Cayuga, Madison, and Oneida Counties. We are hoping to include Cortland and Oswego Counties in the very near future.
