

Dear Property Owner:

RE: **SENIOR CITIZEN EXEMPTION**

As you know, each year we mail to you a renewal form to **extend** your Senior Citizens Exemption to next year.

Governor Andrew Cuomo signed an Executive Order stating that:

**Seniors DO NOT HAVE TO RENEW their Senior Citizen Exemption in 2021.**

The Town of Pompey, Town Board, passed a Resolution adopting this change in procedure.

Your Senior Citizen Exemption will be frozen at its 2020 level for taxes to be levied in 2021 (School in September 2021 and Town and County in January 2022).

If your 2020 income has DECREASED significantly from the 2019 level for any reason such as the loss of a husband or wife, you should contact the Assessor and file a Renewal Form.

Should you know someone who is over 65 and may be eligible for a Senior Citizen Exemption advise that person to contact the Assessor, the income limit for a Senior Citizen Exemption is \$37,400.00. Any new applications must be filed by March 1, 2021.

To restate, remember you **DO NOT HAVE TO FILE** a Senior Citizen Renewal for this year.
